PALM OIL PRICES IN THE LOCAL & EXPORT MARKET TRADED MIXED

Crude Palm Oil (CPO) prices were traded firmer this week, higher by RM17.00 to RM3,909.00/tonne as against RM3,892.00/tonne in the previous week. The highest and lowest traded CPO prices were at RM3,970.00/tonne (8th May) and RM3,800.00/tonne (10th May) respectively. Meanwhile, RBD Palm Olein (FOB) prices were traded lower at US\$846.00/tonne this week as compared to US\$848.00/tonne in the previous week. The lower CPO prices were mainly due to:

- Stronger soyabean oil prices on the Chicago Board of Trade (CBOT) and China's Dalian Commodity Exchange. Palm oil prices are affected by the movement of soyabean oil prices as they compete for a share in the global vegetable oils market.
- Weaker Malaysian Ringgit against the U.S. dollar making the commodity less expensive for buyers.
- Lower palm oil stocks recorded at below 2.0 Mn T.

- CPO price was traded easier, lower by US\$26.00 to US\$983.50/tonne, with premium vis-à-vis SBO price narrowed at US\$25.50/tonne this week.
- RBD Palm Olein price was traded weaker, lower by US\$4.00 to US\$959.50/tonne, with premium of US\$1.50/tonne as against SBO price.
