
- ▶ **Global corn supplies** for 2013-14 are projected higher at **966.92 Mio** t (+0.3% from December estimates and +12% from season 2012-13).
- **U.S.** harvested area for corn is raised 436.000 acres, but the estimated yield is lowered to 158.8 bushels per acre (10 tons/hectare). The expected harvest is still the most bountiful ever recorded, breaking the previous record in 2008/09.
- **Corn used to produce ethanol** is raised 50 million bushels (1.27 Mio t) reflecting: continued strong weekly ethanol production, a reduction in expected sorghum use for ethanol, and higher forecast 2014 gasoline consumption in the latest projections from the U.S. Energy Information Administration.
- ▶ **China** corn production is projected at 217 Mio t (+3% from December estimates, +6% from season 2012-13 and +13% from season 2011-12). In the northeastern region the weather is favorable and the harvested area is raised.



## CORN – Top Producers and Exporters Estimate for 2013-14 Season







- Global soybean production for 2013-14 is projected higher from December estimates, at a record 286.83 Mio t, on gains for the United States and Brazil for the higher projected area.
- ▶ U.S. soybean yield is estimated higher at 43.3 bushels per acre (2.95 tons/hectare); soybean crush is raised reflecting higher projected soybean meal exports during the first quarter of the marketing year.
- Lower soybean meal exports for Argentina resulting from lower soybean crush are offset by gains for the U.S., Brazil and Russia.









