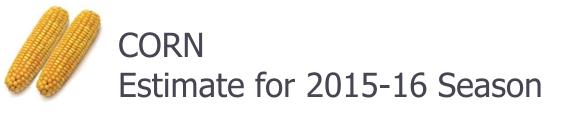

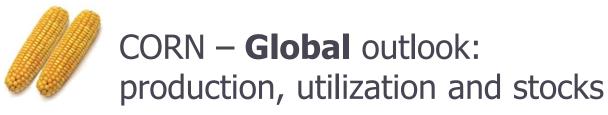
- Global Corn supplies for 2015-16 (new marketing year starting September 1st) are projected at 987.11 Mio t, down 0.2% from June estimates, with reductions in the United States and EU only partly offset by increases for Brazil and China.
- U.S. Corn production for 2015-16 is projected -0.7% reflecting the lower planted and harvested areas. Corn beginning stocks for 2015-16 are -5.2% as increases in 2014-15 feed and residual use, use in ethanol production, and exports more than offset a small increase in imports. Use for ethanol is raised with higher forecasts for 2015 and 2016 gasoline consumption in the latest outlook from the *Energy Information Administration*.
- Corn ending stocks are projected lower also for **Brazil**, where Corn exports are increased both for 2014-15 and for 2015-16, increasing the competition for the U.S.
- EU Corn production is lowered 2.4 Mio t (from 68.14 to 65.77 Mio t) as recent eccessive heat and developing dryness across major growing areas reduces yield prospects. EU Corn imports (14 Mio t) are raised +2 Mio t.

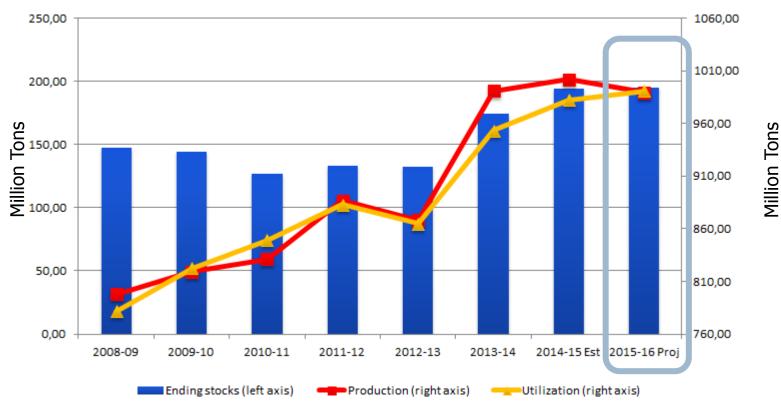

SOYBEANS

Estimate for 2015-16 Season

- Global Soybean production for 2015-16 (new marketing year starting October 1st) is projected at 318.92 Mio t, +1.3 Mio t from June estimates, mostly due to higher production in the United States and Bolivia.
- U.S. harvested area, forecast at 84.4 Mio acres, is +0.7 Mio above the June forecasts. The Soybean yield is projected at 46 bushels per acre (3.13 tons/hectare). Soybean production is projected at 105.73 Mio t (+0.9%).
- U.S. beginning and ending stocks are expected at 6.94 Mio t and 11.58 Mio t, respectively, lower from June estimates.
- The expected Soybean production in Argentina and Brazil, the main Exporters with the U.S., has been confirmed at 57 and 97 Mio t.
- Imports in the major importers are expected unchanged at 77.50 Mio t for China and rising to 10.13 Mio t for the EU.

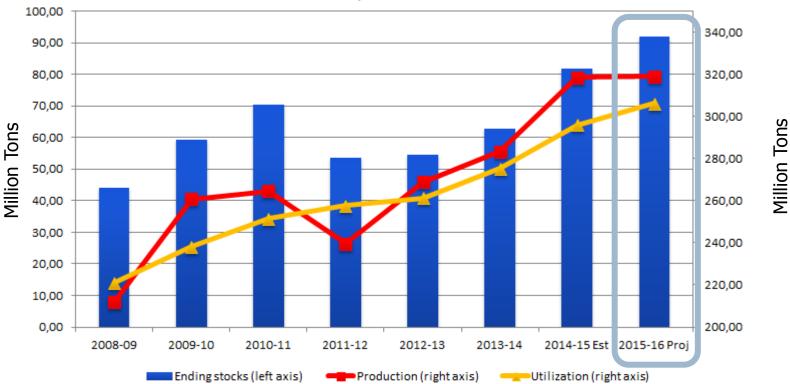

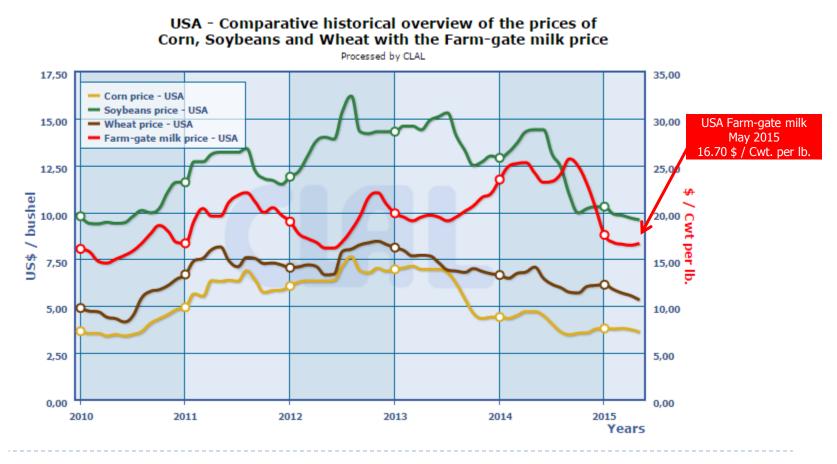

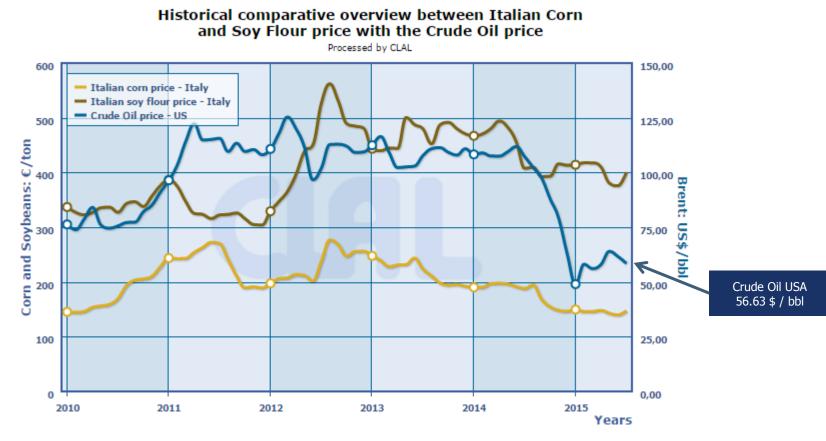
 US – <u>Price comparison</u>: Corn, Soybeans, Wheat and Farm-gate milk price
