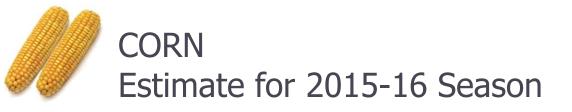

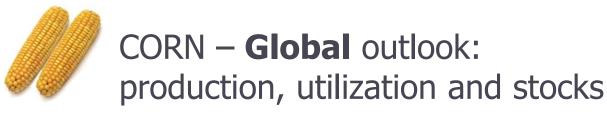
- Global Corn supplies for 2015-16 (new marketing year starting September 1st) are projected at 989.30 Mio t (-0.7% from last month), with reductions for Zambia, Nepal, Zimbabwe and EU.
- **U.S. projected Corn production** is unchanged at **346.22 Mio t**.
- Corn beginning stocks are raised (+0.63 Mio t) with a reduction in 2014-15 forecast corn use in ethanol producion. Corn ending stocks are projected +0.63 Mio t, the same as for beginning stocks.
- Russia Corn production is raised +1 Mio t on a higher area and yield. Planting progress data indicate a year-to-year increase in seeded area, which is also reflected in higher year-to-year imports of agricultural chemicals. The higher production makes the country's Corn supplies very competitive in the Middle East and North Africa.
- Brazil Corn production for 2014-15 is raised 3 Mio t to a near-record 81 Mio t, with higher area and yields, reflecting extended rainfall through May.
- Global Corn ending stocks for 2015-16 are projected at 195.19 Mio t, +3.25 Mio t mostly on the higher stocks expected for Brazil.



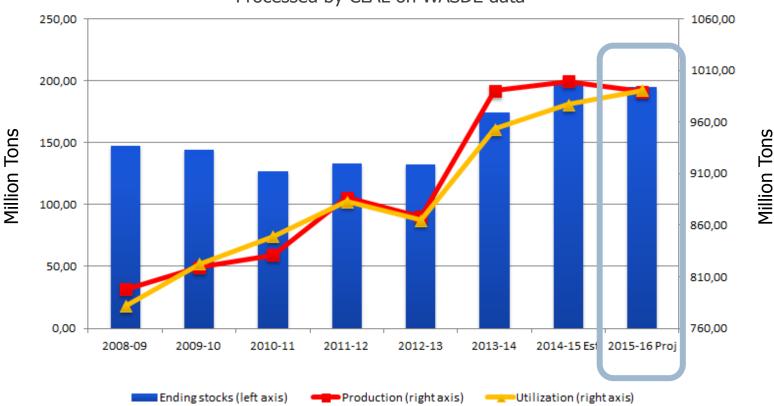

SOYBEANS

Estimate for 2015-16 Season

- Global Soybean production for 2015-16 (new marketing year starting October 1st) is projected at 317.58 Mio t, +0.1% from May estimates, reflecting gains for Russia and the EU.
- In the U.S., the largest Soybean Producer, projections for production and export are unchaged at 104.78 Mio t and 48.31 Mio t.
- Lower beginning stocks reflect higher crush and export projections for 2014-15.
 Ending stocks for 2015-16 are reduced 0.54 Mio t to 12.93 Mio t.
- With the lower stocks in Brazil and in the U.S. only partly offset by higher stocks in Argentina (+1 Mio t), global Soybean stocks for 2015-16 are projected at 93.22 Mio t, -3 mio t from last month.

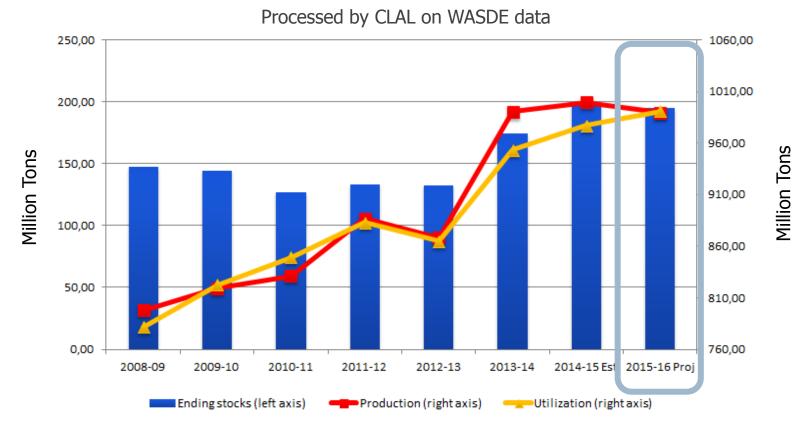

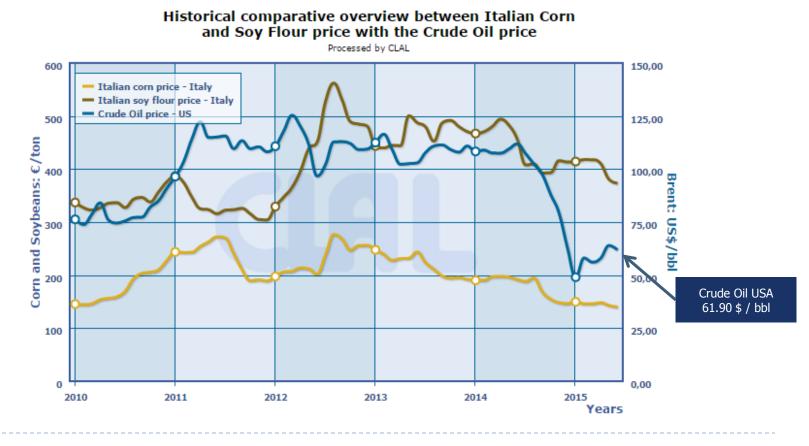
 US – <u>Price comparison</u>: Corn, Soybeans, Wheat and Farm-gate milk price

 <u>Price comparison</u>: Corn (Italy), Soy flour (Italy) and Crude Oil (US)

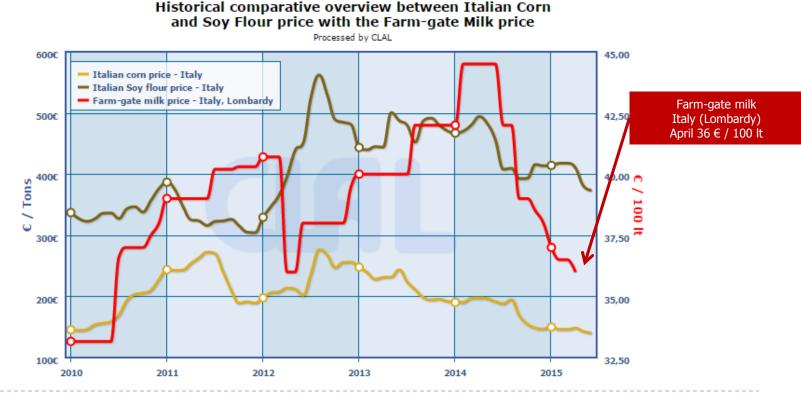

Focus on **Italy** Corn and Soy prices

- <u>National Corn</u> and <u>Soy</u> prices as listed by the Milan Chamber of Commerce, in comparison with the <u>Farm-gate milk price</u>:
 - Italian Corn: 139 ÷ 141 €/ton (-2 € from last month)
 - Italian Soy flour: 368 ÷ 369 €/ton (-6 € from last month)
