## CORN <br> Estimate for 2014-15 Season

- Global Corn supplies for 2014-15 are projected at $\mathbf{9 9 0 . 3 2}$ Mio t, unchanged from last month estimates. Increases for the EU (+2 Mio t), Ukraine (+2 Mio t) and for Mexico (+0.5 Mio t) offset reductions for the U.S. (-1.7 Mio t).
- U.S. Corn production is forecast at $\mathbf{3 6 5 . 9 7}$ Mio $\mathbf{t}$, lower from October projections, but still a record.
- The national average Corn yield is reduced -0.8 bushels per acre to 173.4 bushels (11.01 tons/hectare).
- Corn used in ethanol production is projected higher, with a reduction in expected Sorghum use for ethanol due to higher prices.
- World Corn ending stocks are projected at a record $\mathbf{1 9 1 . 5 0}$ Mio $\mathbf{t}$ with the U.S. reduction more than offset by increases for Mexico, Brazil, Ukraine, China and Argentina.

## SOYBEANS <br> Estimate for 2014-15 Season

- Global Soybean production for 2014-15 season, started on October $1^{\text {st }}$, is projected at a record $\mathbf{3 1 2 . 0 6}$ Mio $\mathbf{t},+0.3 \%$ from last month and $+9.5 \%$ from the previous season.
- U.S. Soybean production is forecast at $\mathbf{1 0 7 . 7 3} \mathbf{~ M i o} \mathbf{t}$ on higher yields. The Soybean yield is projected at a record 47.5 bushels per acre (3.23 tons/hectare).
- Global exports are expected to increase (115.54 Mio t), reflecting higher exports from the U.S. (46.81 Mio $t$ ).
- Global Soybean ending stocks are projected at a record $\mathbf{9 0 . 2 8}$ Mio $\mathbf{t}$, unchanged from October estimates.
