## CORN Estimate for 2014-15 Season

- Global Corn supplies for 2014-15, started September 1st, are projected at 987.52 Mio t, higher compared to August estimates, reflecting higher production in the U.S. (+9.23 Mio t), in Brazil (+1 Mio t) and in the E.U. (+1.3 Mio t).
- U.S. Corn production is forecast at a record 365.66 Mio $t$ with a corn yield raised to 171.7 bushels per acre ( $=10.90$ tons/hectare).
- U.S. Corn exports are projected higher at 44.45 Mio t with lower prices and reduced competition expected from South America later in the marketing year.
- Corn production is reduced for China where output is expected down 5 Mio t based on persistent summer dryness in key growing areas of the North China Plain and Northeast.
- Hot and dry conditions in Ukraine and Russia reduce corn production prospects.
- Global Corn ending stocks are projected at a record $\mathbf{1 8 9 . 9 1}$ Mio t.

## SOYBEANS <br> Estimate for 2014-15 Season

- Global Soybean production for 2014-15 (new marketing year starting October $1^{\text {st }}$ ) is projected at $\mathbf{3 1 1 . 1 3} \mathbf{~ M i o} \mathbf{t}$, higher from the estimates from May to August, reflecting higher production in the largest Exporting Countries.
- In the U.S. the production is expected at 106.50 Mio t (+2.65 compared to August estimates), due to a higher yield forecast.
- Brazil and Argentina production of Soybeans is projected to increase as producers choose to plant Soybeans instead of Corn, based on the strong U.S. Corn crop.
- China Soybean imports are raised 1 Mio t to 74 Mio t, +7\% from 201314 and $+24 \%$ from 2012-13.
- Global Soybean ending stocks are projected at a record $\mathbf{9 0 . 1 7}$ Mio t.
