PALM OIL PRICES IN THE LOCAL & EXPORT MARKET TRADED EASIER

Crude Palm Oil (CPO) prices were traded **easier** this week, **lower by RM114.50 to RM3,850.50/tonne** as against **RM3,965.00/tonne** in the previous week. The highest and lowest traded CPO prices were at RM3,990.00/tonne (29th Jan) and RM3,750.00/tonne (30th Jan) respectively. Meanwhile, **RBD Palm Olein (FOB) prices** were **No Traded** this week. The **lower** CPO prices were mainly due to:

- Stronger Malaysian Ringgit against the U.S. dollar makes palm oil less attractive for foreign currency holders.
- Weaker brent crude oil prices in the world market.
- Weaker soyabean oil prices on the Chicago Board of Trade (CBOT) and China's Dalian Commodity Exchange. Palm oil prices are affected by the movement of soyabean oil prices as they compete for a share in the global vegetable oils market.

- CPO price was traded easier, lower by US\$20.50 to US\$950.00/tonne, with discount vis-à-vis SBO price narrowed at US\$52.50/tonne this week.
- RBD Palm Olein price was traded easier, lower by US\$19.00 to US\$959.50/tonne, with premium of US\$62.00/tonne as against SBO price.
