Free on board spot prices for national dry whole milk are mixed as some spot sales, based on branding, pushed up the bottom price of the range. According to some industry participants, the national dry whole milk market is transitioning from unsettled to stable. This week, the spot trading activity is light as the bulk of sales have been based on contracts. In general, dry whole milk production is irregular, but inventories are enough to meet most spot/contractual needs.
