Rennet and acid casein prices are steady. Markets are quiet, with no reports of any price changing transactions. New Zealand is seasonally not producing for another month or two. Western European production is slow and destined to filling contracts.

United States casein imports January - June 2020, 23,000 MT, decreased 7.5 percent from January - June 2019 according to CLAL data made available to USDA. The three top origins, volumes and percent change include New Zealand, 10,507 MT, -5.7 percent; Ireland, 6,140 MT, -5.7 percent; and France, 3,589 MT, +30 percent.
