The acid and rennet casein price ranges are steady. Sources in Western Europe describe casein markets as stable and quite balanced. Production has begun to gradually increase as milk production increases. New Zealand casein markets are also steady. Production is seasonally declining. Most contracting through Q1 2021 is completed, and contracting for Q2 2021 is well underway.
