The acid casein price range is steady. Rennet casein low range prices advanced, while the top of the price range is steady. Most production is going to fill existing contracts. When non committed casein is available typically that relates to a plant getting a bit ahead of scheduled contract deliveries. The overall market tone is steady. Pricing is expected to stay relatively close to current pricing through 2021.

Casein exports from New Zealand January - October 2021 increased 27.6 percent from January - October 2020 according to CLAL data made available to USDA. The U.S. was the biggest customer, with purchases up 16.73 percent. Number two and three, China and Mexico, were up 59.33 percent and 30.41 percent respectively.
