Dry Whey - Western Europe

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Western European whey prices moved higher at both ends of the price range. Whey production is picking up along with seasonal milk production and increases in cheese production. However, supplies are still tight, and demand is enough to keep prices supported, especially for food applications. Market observers note that buyer activity has eased slightly. Buyer activity for feed application whey may have calmed to a greater extent than the food market, but this has had a minimal effect on the market in total.
