Dry Whole Milk - U.S.

Report 17 - Released on April 28, 2022

Dry whole milk availability remains tight. Spot inventories vary between limited from some manufacturers to unavailable from others. Some buyers have indicated success sourcing partial load purchases, but they say prices are hovering close to the top of the spot price range for less-than-loads. Domestic demand is level. Drying time is intermittent; contractual agreements dictate production schedules. Dry whole milk market tones are steady. The national price range is unchanged from last week.
