Dry Whole Milk - U.S.

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Dry whole milk spot market availability is tight to very tight. Some contacts say sourcing even less-than-load supplies is increasingly challenging, with some partial load transactions reportedly occurring in the mid-2.40s. Domestic demand is flat. Dry whole milk production is sporadic and varies from one manufacturer to the next. Whole milk powder prices slipped in Tuesday's GDT auction. Domestic dry whole milk market tones are unchanged. The national price range is steady on limited full spot load trading activity.

The DMN April 2022 monthly average price for national dry whole milk was \$2.2600, unchanged from one month ago.
