Dry Whole Milk - U.S.

Report 22 - Released on June 02, 2022

National spot prices for dry whole milk are unchanged this shortened holiday week. Inventories are scant, and opportunities are few and far between for full spot load purchasing. Market participants suggest partial load sales and resales are also limited at this time. Dry whole milk drying time is sporadic, and production schedules are largely focused on meeting contractual needs. Some contacts expect dry whole milk output will remain contract-driven for the near term, as labor pool issues and heavy milk usage from other classes hamper production capacity. Domestic dry whole milk market tones are steady.
