Dry Whole Milk - U.S.

Report 23 - Released on June 09, 2022

The bottom of the dry whole milk price range shifted higher this week. Spot inventories are still modest, and full spot load transactions remain a little muted. Some market participants say resales and less-than-load offers are also a little quiet at this time. Dry whole milk drying time is intermittent, and production schedules vary from one facility to the next. Domestic demand is unchanged.

The DMN May 2022 monthly average price for national dry whole milk was \$2.2495, compared to \$2.2600 one month ago.
