Dry Whole Milk - U.S.

Report 25 - Released on June 23, 2022

Dry whole milk inventories remain snug. Spot availability is limited, moderating full load spot trading activity. Production is intermittent. Ongoing staffing shortages have reduced operating capacity at some dairy processing plants, leading some manufacturers to focus drying schedules on the satisfaction of contractual obligations at this time. Domestic demand is flat. The dry whole milk price range is unchanged from last week. Market tones are quietly steady.
