Dry Whole Milk - U.S.

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Dry whole milk production is sporadic, and drying time varies from one processing facility to the next. At some plants, where labor pool issues and supply chain snags constrain operating capacity, production is focused on fulfilling contract agreements. Spot inventories are tight. Some would-be buyers say full load spot offers from manufacturers have been a little quiet. National dry whole milk market tones remain quietly steady, and prices are unchanged this week.
