Dry Whole Milk - U.S.

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Dry whole milk trading activity was a little subdued this holiday-shortened week, and the price range held firm. Production is intermittent. Drying schedules are largely driven by contract obligations. At some plants, dry whole milk production is secondary to drying condensed skim or other commodities. Dry whole milk spot supplies are tight. Domestic demand is level, with confectioners and bakers presenting steady interest for their production needs. National dry whole milk market tones remain steadily quiet.

The DMN June 2022 monthly average price for national dry whole milk was \$2.2702, compared to \$2.2495 one month ago.
