Dry Whole Milk - U.S.

Report 30 - Released on July 28, 2022

Dry whole milk market tones are quietly steady. Domestic demand is flat. Inventories remain slim. Trading activity is a little quiet on limited spot availability. The national price range is unchanged from last week, however, the bulk of trading is occurring closer to the top of the range. Dry whole milk output is sporadic and largely driven by contractual obligations. Production capacity is limited at some plants with staffing shortages, and condensed skim drying time is generally prioritized over whole milk.
