The Oceania cheese price range is steady to higher. Australia's cheddar cheese production is very active, as good domestic demand keeps supplies tight for exporting. North Asians secured the most cheddar at GDT event 321, close to doubling up on the volume purchased last year at this time. Cheddar was available for all contracts, with a firm undertone going into 2023.
