Prices for whole milk powder (WMP) moved lower at the bottom of the range, while the top was unchanged this week. During GDT event 243, WMP and butter were the only two products offered which saw a decline in the all contracts prices. More loads of WMP were sold to GDT participants in North Asia than in any other region. Australian export data for September was recently released and revealed export data during the month and year to date export volumes of WMP were down compared to a year prior. Production of WMP is proceeding steadily in Oceania, meeting seasonal expectations.
