In the West, low/medium heat nonfat dry milk (NDM) prices moved slightly higher on the bottom end of the range, while the top end of the range and both ends of the mostly price series moved slightly lower. Stakeholders report steady to moderate domestic demand following the holiday weekend. A few stakeholders suggest some offers below current market prices for older inventory may take place soon, which could improve activity from spot market buyers. Export demand is moderate. Manufacturers note steady low/medium heat NDM production schedules. High heat NDM prices moved lower on both ends of the range. Stakeholders relay steady to moderate demand. Manufacturers relay steady to moderate production schedules.
