In the West, low/medium heat nonfat dry milk (NDM) prices moved lower on both ends of the range and mostly price series. Stakeholders report steady to moderate domestic demand. While changes in reported demand from Mexican purchasers continue to vary from increasing to decreasing, week to week, overall export demand remains moderate. Manufacturers note steady production schedules. High heat NDM prices moved slightly lower on both ends of the range. Stakeholders indicate mostly steady demand. Some manufacturers relay high heat NDM production is steady, while others relay no further production planned for the finish of 2023. A few stakeholders say supplies are more on the tight end than the loose end.
