In the West, low/medium heat nonfat dry milk (NDM) prices moved slightly lower on the bottom end of the range and mostly price series, but the top end of the range and mostly price series held steady. Stakeholders note domestic demand is steady to moderate. Manufacturers and distributors report availability of spot loads as somewhat tight to somewhat loose. Export demand is moderate and some stakeholders relay decreasing demand from Mexican purchasers. Manufacturers indicate steady production schedules. High heat NDM prices moved slightly lower on both ends of the range. Stakeholders indicate steady to lighter demand. Some manufacturers note steady production schedules. However, other manufacturers have finished planned 2023 production. A few stakeholders relay somewhat tight spot load availability.
