The price range for dry whole milk (DWM) was unchanged this week. Demand for DWM is steady from contract purchasers. Contacts suggest the end of year holidays have contributed to softer spot market demand this week. Nonfat dry milk and skim milk powder are taking priority to DWM in production schedules. The limited DWM being produced is to fulfill contractual requirements and plant managers say few loads are moving onto the spot market. Contacts say this will likely limit growth of DWM spot inventories, which have been tight in recent weeks.
