Nonfat dry milk (NDM) prices are unchanged on the holiday shortened trading week. Contacts expected slower purchasing from south of the U.S. border, as Mexican trading typically slows down for the second half of the month. Low/medium NDM inventories are mixed in the region, but recent availability has been noted as improving for some spot needs. Condensed skim availability has grown, regionally, but contacts say a lot of condensed skim is being used in Class III plants for cheese fortification, as milk availability in the region has been more variant this year. High heat NDM prices are unchanged on slow trading. NDM market tones are quiet.
