



Dry Whey - Europe

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Dry whey prices moved lower at the bottom of the range while the top end advanced this week, reflecting mixed market signals. Buyer interest remained focused on specific volume requirements, providing support to higher-end pricing even as readily available supplies weighed on the lower end of the range. Drying operations continue at active levels, supported by strong milk availability and consistent whey production. Trading activity remained steady throughout the reporting period, with demand varying by destination and specification. Overall sentiment remained constructive, though pricing movement was uneven across the range.
