



Dry Whole Milk - U.S.

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Dry whole milk prices eased at both ends of the range this week but continue to sit above year-ago levels. Production is steady and in line with seasonal norms, keeping inventories generally balanced. Demand remains stable, with most activity tied to ongoing contracts and limited spot interest. Some contacts note older product is trading near \$2.00, while current production loads are securing 20-30 cent higher rates, and export sales are fetching slight premiums. A few contacts note minor declines in offer prices since last week. Overall, the market tone remains steady to firm.
