



Dry Whole Milk - U.S.

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Dry whole milk prices declined at both ends of the range but remained above year-ago levels. Production is steady and inventories are generally balanced. Demand is driven largely by ongoing contracts, with only limited spot activity reported. Some buyers are seeking basis pricing rather than negotiating flat prices. Overall, the market tone is steady to firm.
