Butter prices held steady during the reporting period. Processor prices moved lower compared to last month and remain significantly below year-ago levels. The futures curve softened across all contract periods, with the largest declines in November and December, both down 2.8 percent.

The next Global Dairy Trade event is scheduled for July 7.

Recently released New Zealand export data indicates that May 2026 butter exports totaled 26,814 metric tons (MT), a 24 percent increase from the previous year. Cumulative butter exports from January through May 2026 reached 132,208 MT, up 7.2 percent compared to the same period a year earlier.
