



Dry Whole Milk - U.S.

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The dry whole milk market is holding at a steady state this week. The market tone remains stable, with overall market activity reported as quiet. The price range for dry whole milk dropped at both ends of the range, keeping pace with the nonfat dry milk market. Demand is steady and inventories are manageable, with production largely focused on contracted volumes. Contacts indicate organic dry whole milk is difficult to find on the spot market and trading at a significant premium to the conventional market.
