



PALM OIL PRICE REPORT ON 41st WEEK (9th - 13th Oct 2023)

PALM OIL PRICES IN THE LOCAL & EXPORT MARKETS TRADED EASIER

Crude Palm Oil (CPO) prices were traded **easier** this week, **lower by RM53.50 to RM3,586.50/tonne** as against **RM3,640.00/tonne** in the previous week. The highest and lowest traded CPO prices were at RM3,670.00/tonne (13th Oct) and RM3,470.00/tonne (10th Oct) respectively. Meanwhile, **RBD Palm Olein (FOB) prices** were traded **easier** this week at **USD798.50/tonne** as compared to **USD807.00/tonne** in the previous week. The lower CPO prices were mainly due to:

- Weaker soyabean oil prices on the Chicago Board of Trade (CBOT) and China's Dalian Commodity Exchange. Palm oil prices are affected by the movement of soyabean oil prices as they compete for a share in the global vegetable oils market.
- Lower PO exports demand from major importing countries.
- Higher CPO production and palm oil stocks due to seasonal trend and sluggish demand.

- **CPO** price was traded **firm**, **higher by US\$5.00 to US\$904.50/tonne**, with discount vis-à-vis SBO price widened at US\$233.50/tonne this week.
- **RBD Palm Olein** price was traded **easier**, **lower by US\$9.50 to US\$907.50/tonne**, with discount of US\$230.50/tonne as against SBO price.
