



PALM OIL PRICE REPORT ON 15TH WEEK (06TH – 10TH APRIL 2026)

PALM OIL PRICES IN THE LOCAL & EXPORT MARKET TRADED EASIER

Crude Palm Oil (CPO) prices were traded **easier** this week, **down by RM44.00 to RM4,683.50/tonne** as against **RM4,727.50/tonne** in the previous week. The highest and lowest traded CPO prices were at 4,790.00/tonne (6th & 7th April 2026) and RM4,490.00/tonne (10th April 2026) respectively. Meanwhile, **RBD Palm Olein** prices were traded **lower, down by US\$18.00 to US\$1,192.00/tonne** as against **US\$1,210.00/tonne** in the previous week. The **lower** CPO prices were mainly due to:

- Anticipation of weaker palm oil export demand from major importing countries.
- Appreciation of the ringgit against the US dollar.
- Expectations of increased CPO production in line with seasonal trends.

PALM OIL PRICES IN THE EUROPE MARKET TRADED MIXED

- **CPO** price was traded **firmer, up by US\$3.50 to US\$1,568.50/tonne**, with **premium** vis-à-vis SBO price at US\$231.50/tonne this week.
- **RBD Palm Olein** price was traded **easier, down by US\$20.00 to US\$1,298.50/tonne**, with **discount** of US\$38.50/tonne as against SBO price.
