



PALM OIL PRICE REPORT ON 18TH WEEK (27TH APRIL – 1ST MAY 2026)

PALM OIL PRICES IN THE LOCAL & EXPORT MARKET TRADED EASIER

Crude Palm Oil (CPO) prices were traded **easier** this week, **down by RM21.50 to RM4,488.00/tonne** as against **RM4,509.50/tonne** in the previous week. The highest and lowest traded CPO prices were at 4,565.00/tonne (29th April 2026) and RM4,380.00/tonne (27th April 2026) respectively. Meanwhile, **RBD Palm Olein** prices were **No Traded** this week. The **lower** CPO prices were mainly due to:

- Expectations of lower palm oil export demand from major importing countries.
- Expectations of higher CPO production due to seasonal trends.
- Strengthening ringgit as against US dollar.

- **CPO** price was traded **easier**, **down by US\$6.50 to US\$1,535.00/tonne**, with **premium** vis-à-vis SBO price at US\$165.00/tonne this week.
- **RBD Palm Olein** price was traded **easier**, **down by US\$1.00 to US\$1,290.50/tonne**, with **discount** of US\$79.50/tonne as against SBO price.
