



PALM OIL PRICE REPORT ON 25TH WEEK (15TH – 19TH JUNE 2026)

PALM OIL PRICES IN THE LOCAL & EXPORT MARKET TRADED EASIER

Crude Palm Oil (CPO) prices were traded **easier** this week, **down by RM11.50 to RM4,461.00/tonne** as against **RM4,472.50/tonne** in the previous week. The highest and lowest traded CPO prices were at RM4,570.00/tonne (19th June 2026) and RM4,330.00/tonne (16th June 2026) respectively. Meanwhile, **RBD Palm Olein (FOB) prices** were traded easier this week, lower by **US\$1.00/tonne to US\$1,139.00/tonne** as against **US\$1,140.00/tonne** in the previous week. The **lower** CPO prices were mainly due to:

- Lower Brent crude oil prices in the global market.
- Expectations of lower palm oil exports to major importing countries.
- Expectations of higher CPO production due to seasonal trend.

- **CPO** price was traded **firmer**, **up by US\$11.00 to US\$1,583.00/tonne**, with **premium** vis-à-vis SBO price at US\$258.50/tonne this week.
- **RBD Palm Olein** price was traded **easier**, **down by US\$4.00 to US\$1,245.50/tonne**, with **discount** of US\$79.00/tonne as against SBO price.
