

PALM OIL PRICE REPORT ON 26TH WEEK (22ND – 26TH JUNE 2026)

PALM OIL PRICES IN THE LOCAL & EXPORT MARKET TRADED FIRMER

Crude Palm Oil (CPO) prices were traded **firmer** this week, **up by RM74.00 to RM4,535.00/tonne** as against **RM4,461.00/tonne** in the previous week. The highest and lowest traded CPO prices were at RM4,600.00/tonne (23rd June 2026) and RM4,400.00/tonne (25th June 2026) respectively. Meanwhile, **RBD Palm Olein (FOB) prices** were traded firmer this week, up by **US\$4.00/tonne to US\$1,143.00/tonne** as against **US\$1,139.00/tonne** in the previous week. The **higher** CPO prices were mainly due to:

- Expectations of higher palm oil exports demand to major importing countries.
- A weakening ringgit against the US dollar makes palm oil less expensive for foreign buyers.
- Positive market sentiment regarding higher biodiesel blending rates in Malaysia and Indonesia.

- **CPO** price was traded **easier**, **down by US\$8.00 to US\$1,575.00/tonne**, with **premium** vis-à-vis SBO price at US\$272.50/tonne this week.
- **RBD Palm Olein** price was traded **firmer**, **up by US\$3.00 to US\$1,248.50/tonne**, with **discount** of US\$54.00/tonne as against SBO price.
