



PALM OIL PRICE REPORT ON 13TH WEEK (23RD – 27TH MARCH 2026)

PALM OIL PRICES IN THE LOCAL & EXPORT MARKET TRADED EASIER

Crude Palm Oil (CPO) prices were traded **easier** this week, **down by RM7.50 to RM4,507.00/tonne** as against **RM4,514.50/tonne** in the previous week. The highest and lowest traded CPO prices were at 4,565.00/tonne (24th March 2026) and RM4,430.00/tonne (26th March 2026) respectively. Meanwhile, **RBD Palm Olein** prices were traded **lower, down by US\$25.50 to US\$1,180.00/tonne** as against **US\$1,205.50/tonne** in the previous week. The **lower** CPO prices were mainly due to:

- Lower global soybean oil prices continue to put pressure on palm oil prices, as both oils compete within the global vegetable oils complex.
- A strengthening ringgit against the US dollar makes palm oil more expensive for foreign buyers.

- **CPO** price was traded **firmer, up by US\$5.00 to US\$1,510.00/tonne**, with **premium** vis-à-vis SBO price at US\$181.00/tonne this week.
- **RBD Palm Olein** price was traded **easier, down by US\$26.50 to US\$1,285.50/tonne**, with **discount** of US\$43.50/tonne as against SBO price.
