



PALM OIL PRICE REPORT ON 22ND WEEK (25TH – 29TH MAY 2026)

PALM OIL PRICES IN THE LOCAL & EXPORT MARKET TRADED EASIER

Crude Palm Oil (CPO) prices were traded **easier** this week, **lower by RM55.00 to RM4,444.50/tonne** as against **RM4,499.50/tonne** in the previous week. The highest and lowest traded CPO prices were at RM4,500.00/tonne (28th May 2026) and RM4,310.00/tonne (26th May 2026) respectively. Meanwhile, **RBD Palm Olein (FOB) prices** were traded easier this week, lower by **US\$18.00/tonne to US\$1,160.50/tonne** as against **US\$1,178.50/tonne** in the previous week. The **lower** CPO prices were mainly due to:

- Anticipated decline in palm oil export demand from major importers.
- Lower soybean oil prices in the global market.
- Lower Brent crude oil prices in the global market.

- **CPO** price was traded **firmer**, **up by US\$91.50 to US\$1,498.50/tonne**, with **premium** vis-à-vis SBO price at US\$184.00/tonne this week.
- **RBD Palm Olein** price was traded **easier**, **down by US\$10.50 to US\$1,271.50/tonne**, with **discount** of US\$43.50/tonne as against SBO price.
